CRISPR could turn genes on and off with help of nanobodies

"CRISPR can precisely locate specific cenes," "aid Lacramioara Bintu, an assis-
tant professor of bioengineering at Stanford. "What we did was attach CRISPR to nanobodiesto help it perform specific actions when it reached the right spot from gene-editing scissors into a nanoscale control agent that can toggle specissors," Bintu said. The novel technique her team describes in the journa Nature Communinatations could enable researchers to explore new therapeutic
applications in the field of epigenetics - which is the study of how genes
